ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

This Acceptable Use Policy document, including the following list of Prohibited Activities, is an integral part of your Service Agreement with Free Range Internet LLC (FRI). If you engage in any of the activities prohibited by this AUP document FRI may suspend or terminate your service.

FRI's Acceptable Use Policy (the "Policy") for FRI Services is designed to help protect FRI, FRI's customers and the Internet community in general from irresponsible or, in some cases, illegal activities. The Policy is a non-exclusive list of the actions prohibited by FRI. FRI reserves the right to modify the Policy at any time, effective upon posting at https://ajofreerange.com/Acceptable_Use_Policy.pdf.

Prohibited Uses of FRI Systems and Services:

1. Transmission, distribution or storage of any material in violation of any applicable law or regulation is prohibited. This includes, without limitation, material protected by copyright, trademark, trade secret or other intellectual property right used without proper authorization, and material that is obscene, defamatory, constitutes an illegal threat, or violates export control laws.
2. Sending Unsolicited Bulk Email ("UBE", "spam"). The sending of any form of Unsolicited Bulk Email through FRI's network or servers is prohibited. Likewise, the sending of UBE from another service provider advertising a web site, email address or utilizing any resource hosted on FRI's network or servers, is prohibited. FRI accounts or services may not be used to solicit customers from, or collect replies to, messages sent from another Internet Service Provider where those messages violate this Policy or that of the other provider.
3. Advertising, transmitting, or otherwise making available any software, program, product, or service that is designed to violate this AUP or the AUP of any other Internet Service Provider, which includes, but is not limited to, the facilitation of the means to send Unsolicited Bulk Email, flooding, mail-bombing, or denial of service attacks.
4. Unauthorized attempts by a user to gain access to any account or computer resource not belonging to that user (e.g., "cracking").
5. Obtaining or attempting to obtain service by any means or device with intent to avoid payment.
6. Unauthorized access, alteration, destruction, or any attempt thereof, of any information of any FRI customers or end-users by any means or device.

7. Knowingly engage in any activities designed to harass, or that will cause a denial-of-service (e.g., synchronized number sequence attacks) to any other user whether on the FRI network or on another provider's network.
8. Using FRI's Services to interfere with the use of the FRI network by other customers or authorized users.

Customer Responsibility

Each FRI customer is responsible for their activities and the activities of any that use their FRI service, and by accepting service from FRI, is agreeing to abide by and ensure other users of their service abide by this Policy. Complaints about users of a FRI service will be forwarded to the FRI customer for action. If violations of the FRI Acceptable Use Policy occur, FRI reserves the right to terminate services with or take action to stop the offending customer from violating FRI's AUP as FRI deems appropriate, without notice.

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
